New Library Opening in Delano

We are eagerly awaiting a new chapter of our City's public library system.

The new 105,200-square-foot Advanced Learning Library will open at 9 A.M. Saturday, June 16th at 711 W. 2nd St. The new "library of the future" design features expanded access with 60% of the floor space usable by patrons. Amenities include a coffee shop, classrooms, children's and teens areas, collaboration spaces, improved parking, and better access to technology with 75 public computers and later can add up to 35 more.

The existing Central Library, located at 223 S. Main, will cease operation on May 6th to prepare and move around 430,000 items in the collection for the grand opening of the new library. Patrons only had access to 40% of the 89,000 square feet, and 31 public computers. Join us for the Grand Opening festivities that are expected to include a book brigade, ribbon cutting, public tours, technology demonstrations, and special children's activities.

Rock the Block

Join us on May 12th from Noon to 3PM at Seneca Park for the first in our summer concert series. These first two concerts will include music from Hope 4 Da Hood and The District Church Band. There will also be food trucks, games, free prizes, and activities for the kids. There will be no admission fee charged, but you might want to bring some cash for the food trucks. Volunteers and police will be at each intersection to control traffic along the route that goes through part of Delano. We encourage you to go outside if you live along the route, create a festive atmosphere and cheer on these athletes.

North Riverside Stroll, June 9, 10am-4pm. The biennial North Riverside Neighborhood Association Garden Stroll in Wichita, KS. This event is a fundraiser for the continued care of the following Wichita Beautification areas: 13th & Bitting/Jeannette triangle, south of Southwest Nat'l Bank on Coolidge "entrance corner", north of 13th at McKee, Coolidge and Woodrow Ct. intersection triangle, and St. Patrick's Community Garden west of Arkansas on 20th.

Maintenance to these neighborhood beauty areas is performed by volunteers and the funds provided by the Stroll supply the flowers and trees for the mini-parks.

If you take the survey using your cell phone, you will automatically update a map that city and county planners, transit, and others can use to prioritize improvements. In the less than five minutes, you can input data!

Smoking materials are the leading cause of fire deaths, but they are preventable!

>If you smoke, smoke outside. Most deaths result from fires that started in the living room, family rooms and dens or bedrooms.

>NEVER smoke while you are in bed. Cigarettes don't know when you fall asleep.

>Keep cigarettes, lighters, matches and other smoking materials up high out of reach of children.

>Use a deep sturdy ashtray and place it away from anything that can burn.

>Before you throw away butts and ashes, make sure they are out, and dousing in water or sand is the best way to do that.

>Never smoke and never allow anyone to smoke where medical oxygen is used.

Please remember that dry conditions and high winds set up a great fire danger. No outdoor burning...


